We will be learning to:

- Explore British Values and what they mean to us
- Plan and carry out a series of simple electrical circuit investigations

- Draw a circuit diagram with a summary of the brightness, volume and speed of components within it
- Investigate and develop a dimmer switch
- About enterprise and the skills that make someone 'enterprising' • About the role money plays in their own and others' lives (including how to manage their money) and about being a critical consumer
- To develop an initial understanding of the concepts of 'interest', 'loan', 'debt' and 'tax'
- How our body changes.

## Maths

We will be studying:

- Solve problems involving measure [for example, length, mass volume, money] using decimal notation, including scaling
- Statistics and constructing pie charts and line graphs
- Understand the order of operations
- Handling money on a daily basis improving their mental arithmetic
- Applying maths skills in the context of business and enterprise.
