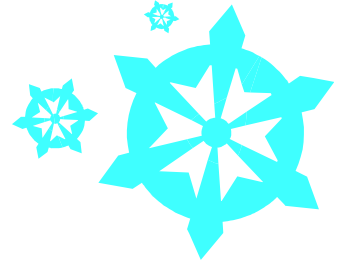


Elm Class Snow Pack

Snow/school closure activities

Listed below are some activities that your child could involve him/herself in at home in the event of snow/school closure.

- Describe what snow looks and feels like. Try to write these words down.

- Paint on ice or snow. Discuss what happens.
- Draw a picture of a hat, scarf and gloves you would like to wear on a cold day. Draw a pattern on them.
- Make a snowman outside and take a picture (if you have a camera).
- Make a model/picture of a snowy day.
- Make some paper snowflakes.
- Write about what you did on a snowy day.
- Write your name in the snow.
- Run around in the snow making tracks that are curved, zigzags etc.
